I would love to read an exposition of the book of Acts that showed Paul, the other apostles, and their co-workers, made most of their decisions by listening for inward impressions, but it requires reading that doctrine into the text, rather than expositing the text. Friesen. In order to arrive at the conclusion of the traditional approach [to decision-making], it is necessary to water down the examples and spice up the biblical teaching. Examples [like in Acts] are watered down to be less miraculous than they really are [so we can't do them too]. Biblical teaching [like in the epistles] must be spiced up to be more specific than it really is [for example, a promise to Israel to "guide you continually" (Is. 58:11), doesn't actually say anything about Christians being guided by 'inward impressions']. Paul made most of his decisions by the Word and Wisdom, not by inward

impressions, and only rarely by direct revelation, even though he was an apostle on the cutting-edge of Jesus' mission to bring the gospel to the Gentiles. Most of Paul's decisions in Acts can be explained 17 principles he followed. Commentators across the political spectrum have argued that the future has been absorbed by an ever-expanding present to which we cannot imagine alternatives. The notion that we have lost the ability to imagine change-culturally, socially, and politically-has become one of the defining problems of our time. The reader is transported to the bridge to stand alongside Admiral Walden Ainsworth as he sails to stop another Japanese reinforcement convoy for New Georgia, and vividly feels the fear of an 18-year-old Marine as he fights for survival against a weakened but still determined enemy. *Dark Waters, Starry Skies* is an engrossing history which weaves together strategy and tactics with a blow-by-blow account of events at a vital point in the Pacific War that has not been analyzed in this level of detail before.

In *Carceral Afterlives*, Katherine Bruce-Lockhart traces the politics, practices, and lived experiences of incarceration in postcolonial Uganda, focusing on the period between independence in 1962 and the beginning of Yoweri Museveni’s presidency in 1986. During these decades, Ugandans experienced multiple changes of government, widespread state violence, and war, all of which affected the government’s approach to punishment. Bruce-Lockhart analyzes the relationship between the prison system and other sites of confinement—including informal detention spaces known as “safe houses” and wartime camps—and considers other forms of punishment, such as public executions and “disappearance” by state paramilitary organizations. Through archival and personal collections, interviews with Ugandans who lived through these decades, and a range of new sources and memoirs, Bruce-Lockhart examines how carceral systems were imagined and experienced by Ugandans held within, working within, and impacted by them. She shows how Uganda’s postcolonial leaders, especially Milton Obote and Idi Amin, attempted to harness the symbolic, material, and coercive power of prisons in the pursuit of a range of

political agendas. She also examines the day-to-day realities of per spaces and public perceptions of punishment by tracing the exper of Ugandans who were incarcerated, their family members and frie prison officers, and other government employees. Furthermore, sh shows how the carceral arena was an important site of dissent, e how those inside and outside of prisons and other spaces of capt challenged the state's violent punitive tactics. Using Uganda as a c study, *Carceral Afterlives* emphasizes how prisons and the wider u confinement—both as a punishment and as a vehicle for other mo punishment—remain central to state power in the Global South an While scholars have closely analyzed the prison's expansion throug colonial rule and the rise of mass incarceration in the United State have largely taken for granted its postcolonial persistence. In cont Bruce-Lockhart demonstrates how the prison's transition from a c to a postcolonial institution explains its ubiquity and reveals ways critique and challenge its ongoing existence. The book thus explor broader questions about the unfinished work of decolonization, th relationship between incarceration and struggles for freedom, and prison's enduring yet increasingly contested place in our global institutional landscape. Romans 9, & John 6." As in Romans 8, we were predestined to

glorification, not to faith or unbelief; so in Romans 9, Israel was predestined to glorification, not to faith or unbelief. The best way demonstrate this is by Paul's examples of the adversaries Pharaoh and Moses. Despite the unscriptural claims of Calvinists, Pharaoh was not hardened about believing in God or the gospel. Over and over the scripture makes it clear that God hardened Pharaoh's heart about letting his people go. "I will harden his heart, so that he will not let his people go," Ex. 4:21. See also Ex. 7:14; 8:32; 9:7; 10:20, 27; 11:10, 12. And God didn't harden Pharaoh's heart so that he would go to hell, so that once Pharaoh had made his decision not to let Israel go, he wouldn't give in too soon due to weakness or aversion to pain, so that God could complete all ten plagues and destroy the mightiest army in the world of that time in the sea, so that all the world would hear of it. "I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and multiply my signs and my wonders in the land of Egypt, ... so that I can lay my hand on Egypt, and bring forth my armies, and my people the children of Israel, out of the land of Egypt by great judgments," Ex. 7:3-4. See also Ex. 10:1-2, 7; 9:1; 14:4, 17. As Paul says in our passage, "Even for this same purpose I have raised you [an unbeliever] up [to be Pharaoh], so that I could show my power in you, and so that my name would be declared throughout all the earth," Rom. 9:17. In contrast to Pharaoh, Moses accomplished something that was not predestined at all, through his free-will choice. When Israel sinned by worshipping the golden calf, Moses interceded, and was granted mercy for them. But then Moses went beyond even that, and asked to share in God's glory as a gracious favor, and was also granted that request. "[Moses] said, 'I beseech you, show me your glory.' And [the LORD] said, 'I will make all my goodness pass before you, ... and will be gracious to you, and will be gracious, and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy,' Rom. 9:18-19.
